Initially founded as an independent company HCTC GmbH was incorporated into Hannover Medical School in December 2018.

The clinical trial management activities include full regulatory support (EU-wide multinational trials), clinical monitoring, site management, data management (GAMP-adapted validated EDC system), and medical writing.
